For the best viewing experience, we recommend that you join the conference using a desktop computer or laptop using **latest version of Chrome or Firefox**.

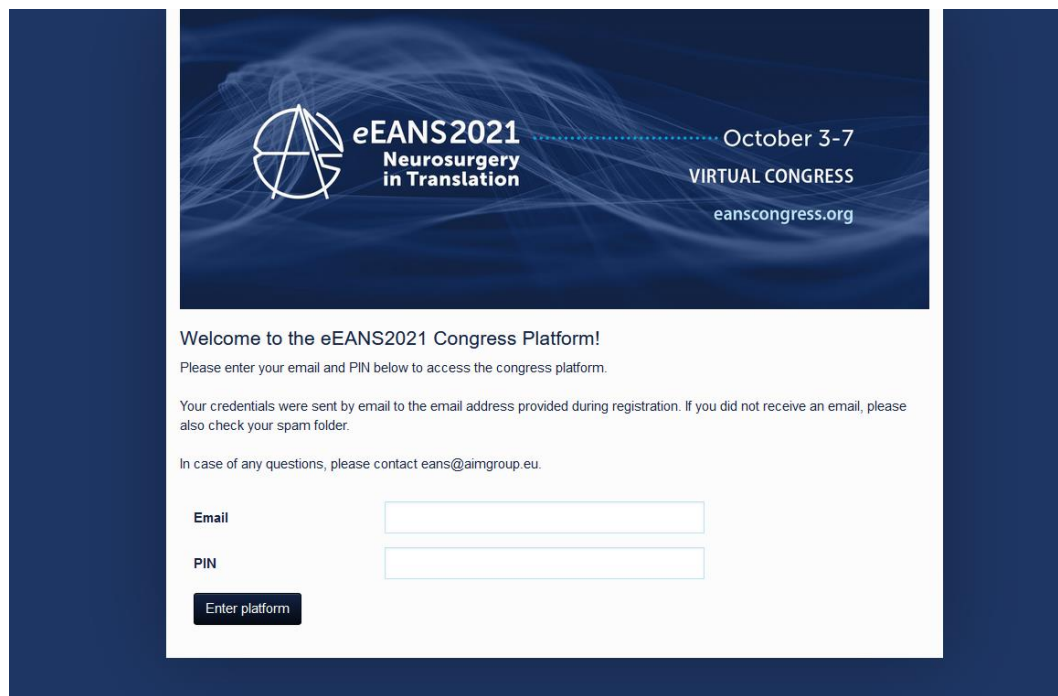
# Accessing the Congress Platform

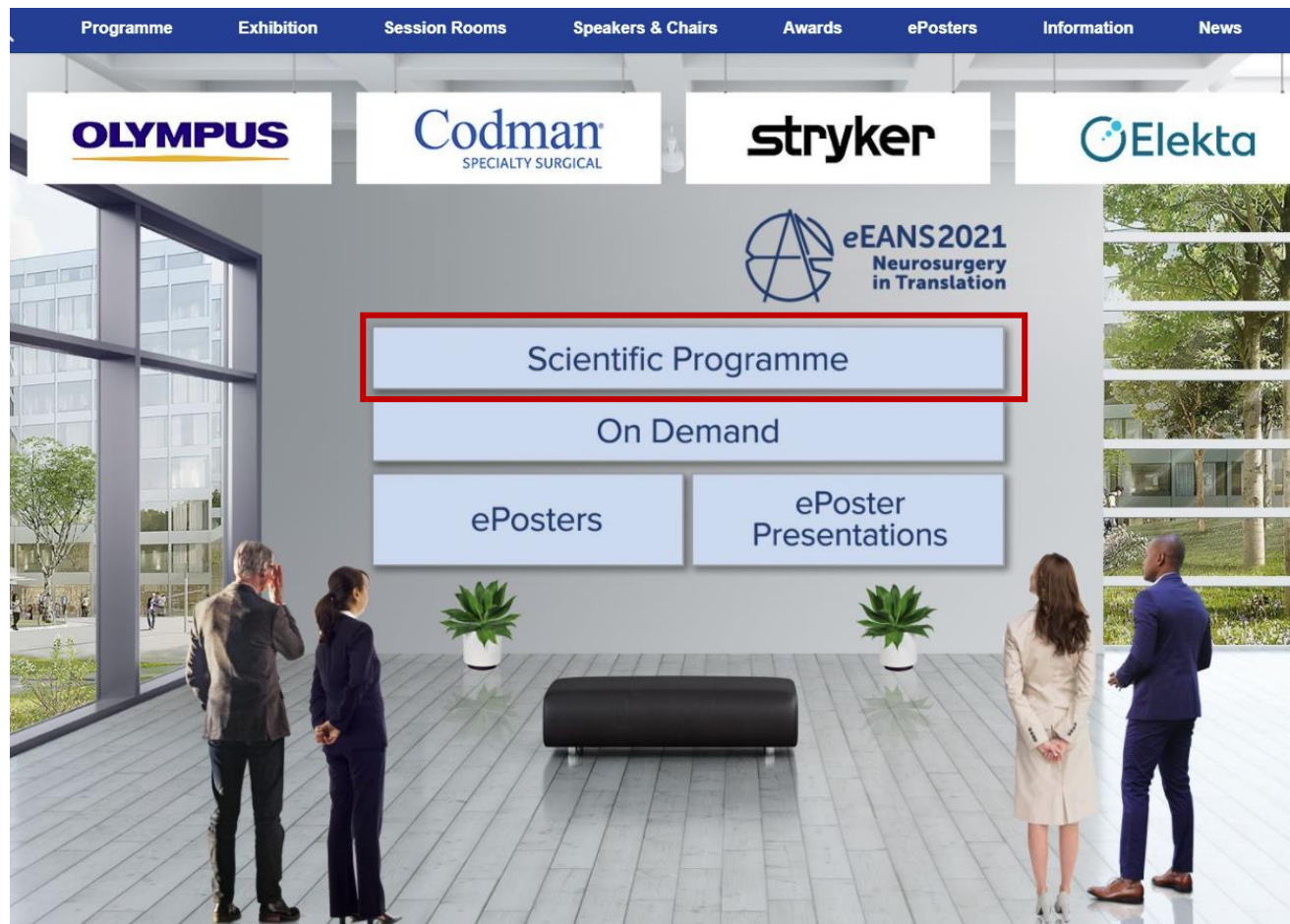

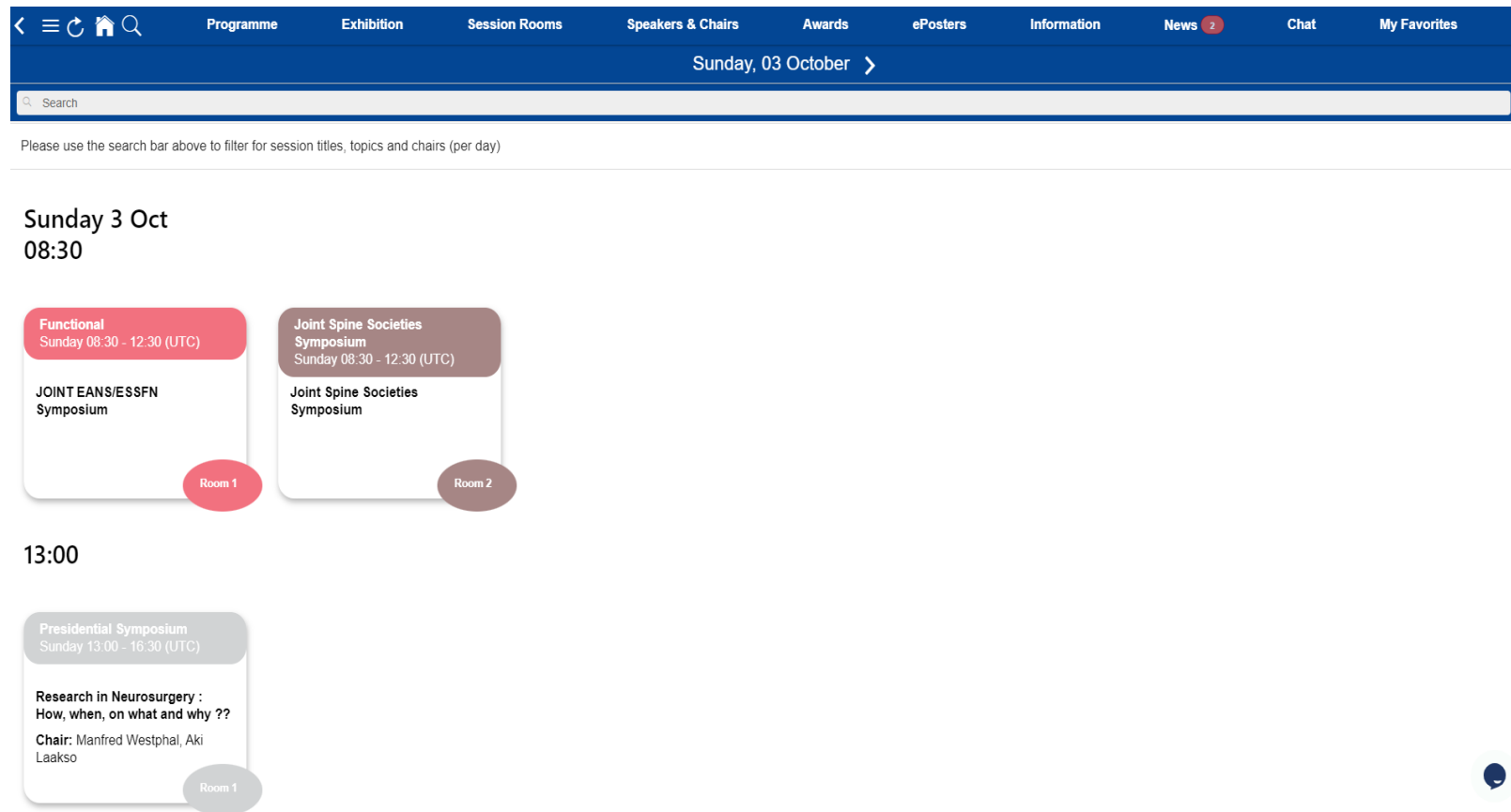

All presentations can be accessed in the On Demand section a few hours after the session was live. Navigate through the menu or use the search bar on top to search for keywords or speakers.

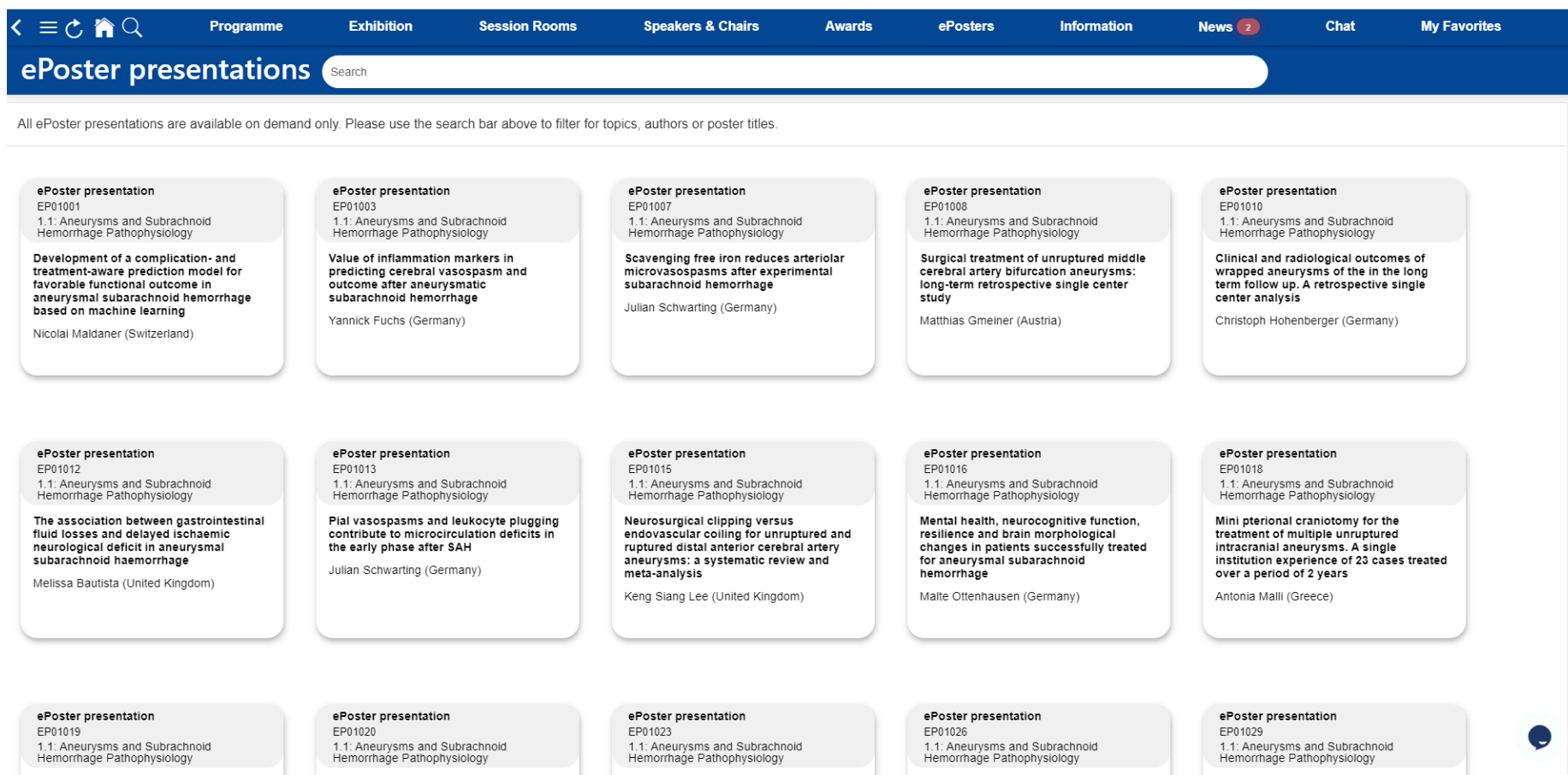

  - Mini pterional craniotomy for the treatment of multiple unruptured intracranial aneurysms. A single institution experience of 23 cases treated over a period of 2 years

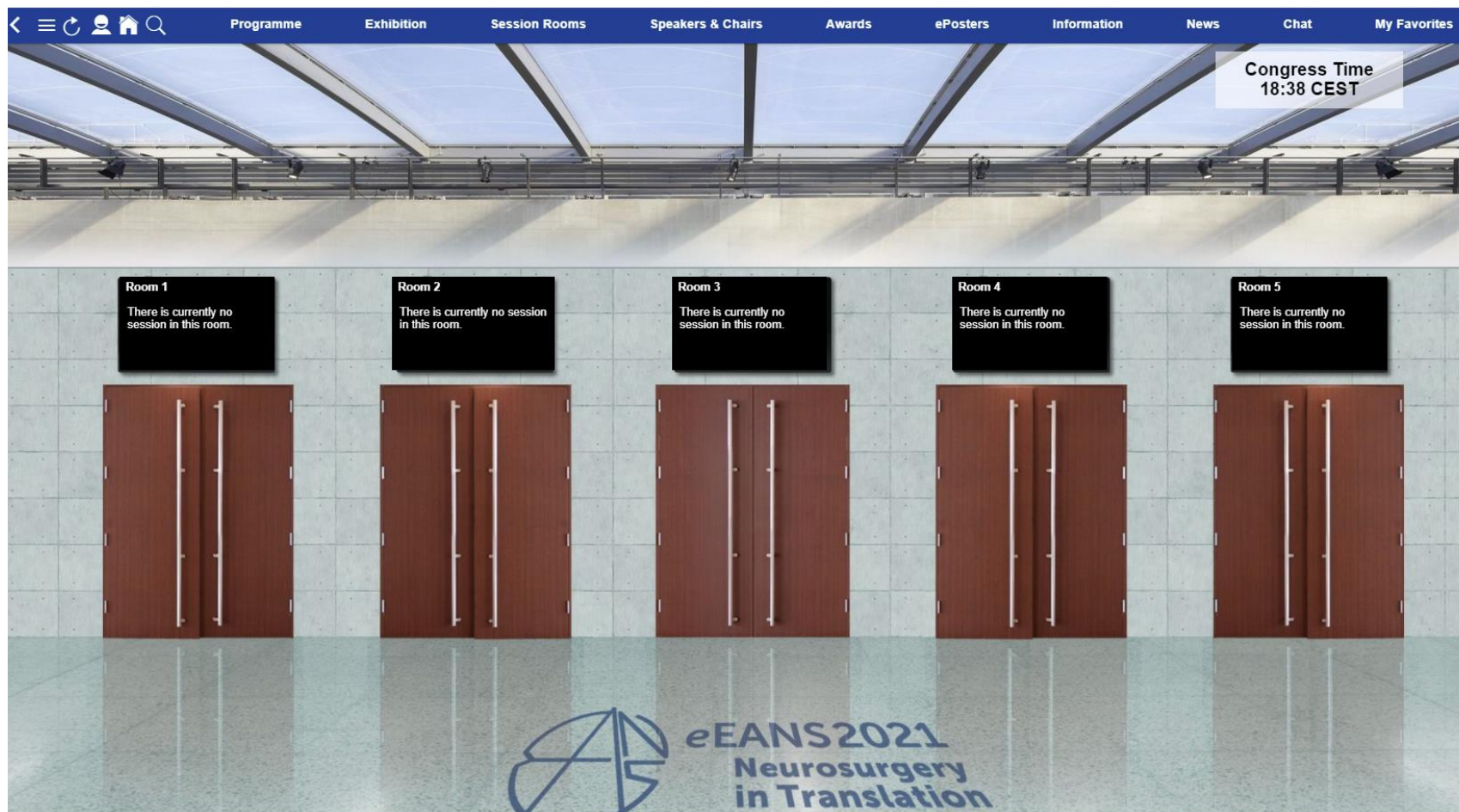

# Session Rooms

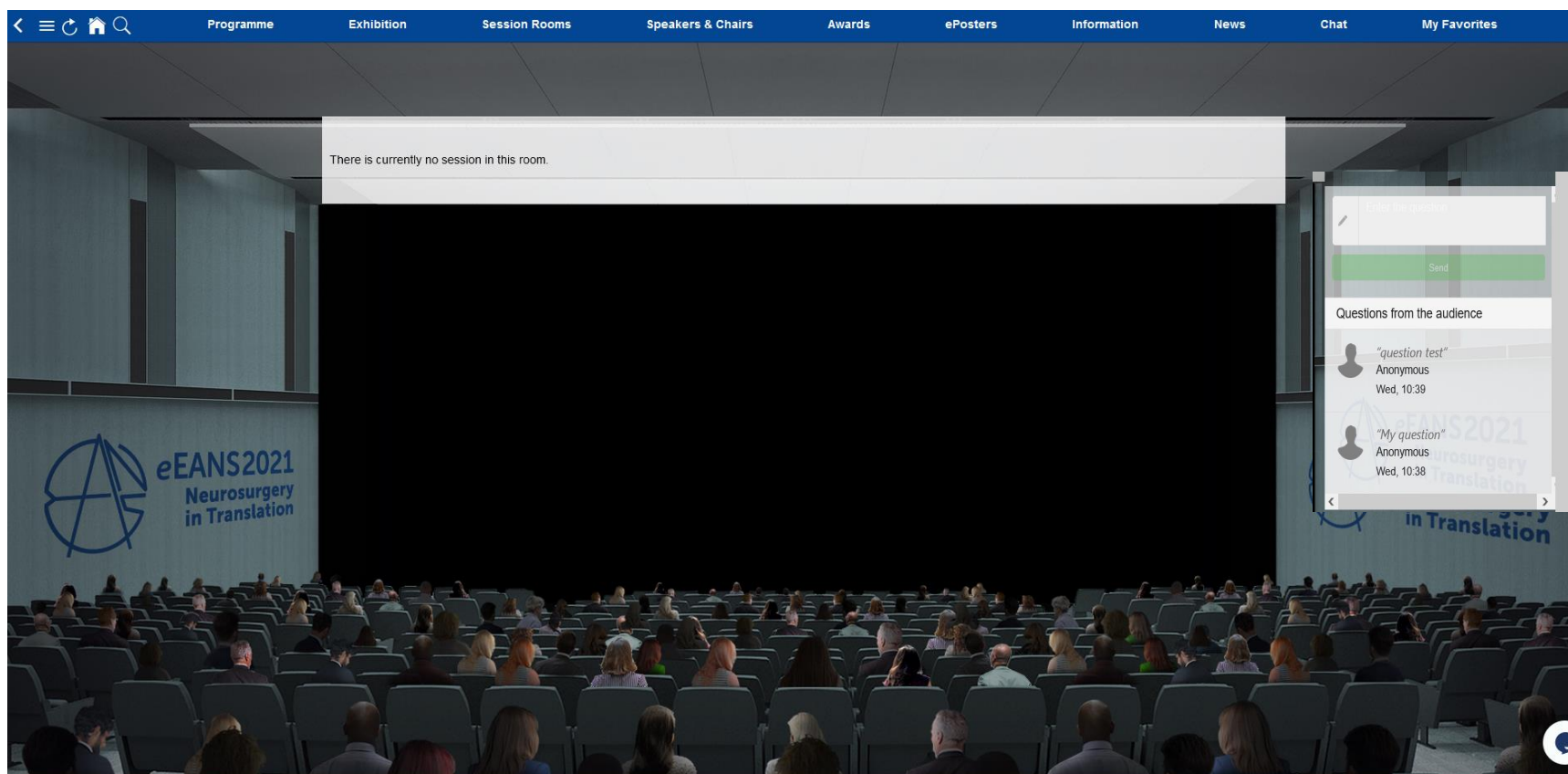
Via the Session Rooms tab you can access the live streams of each room. The current session is displayed on the screens above each room.

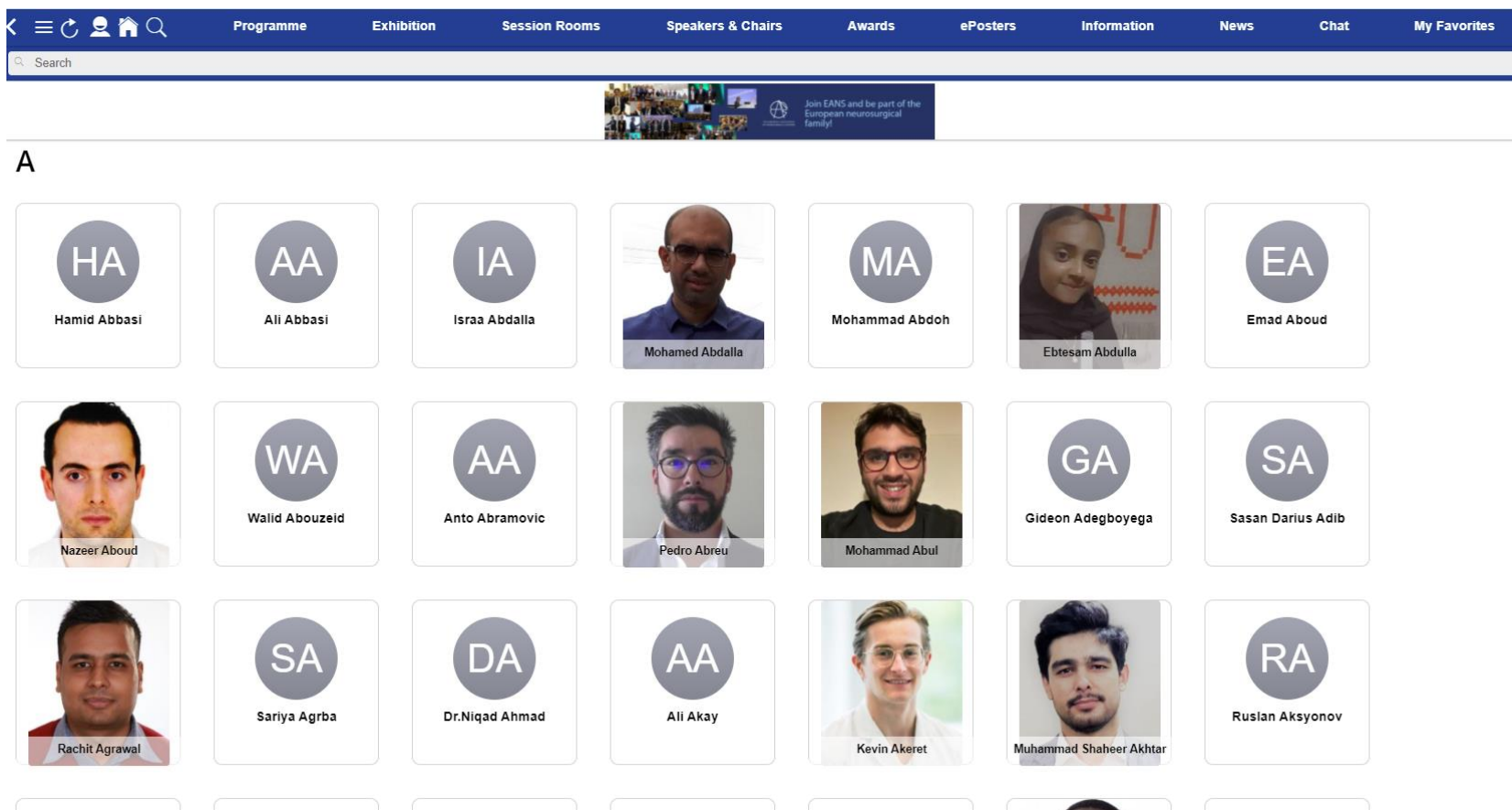

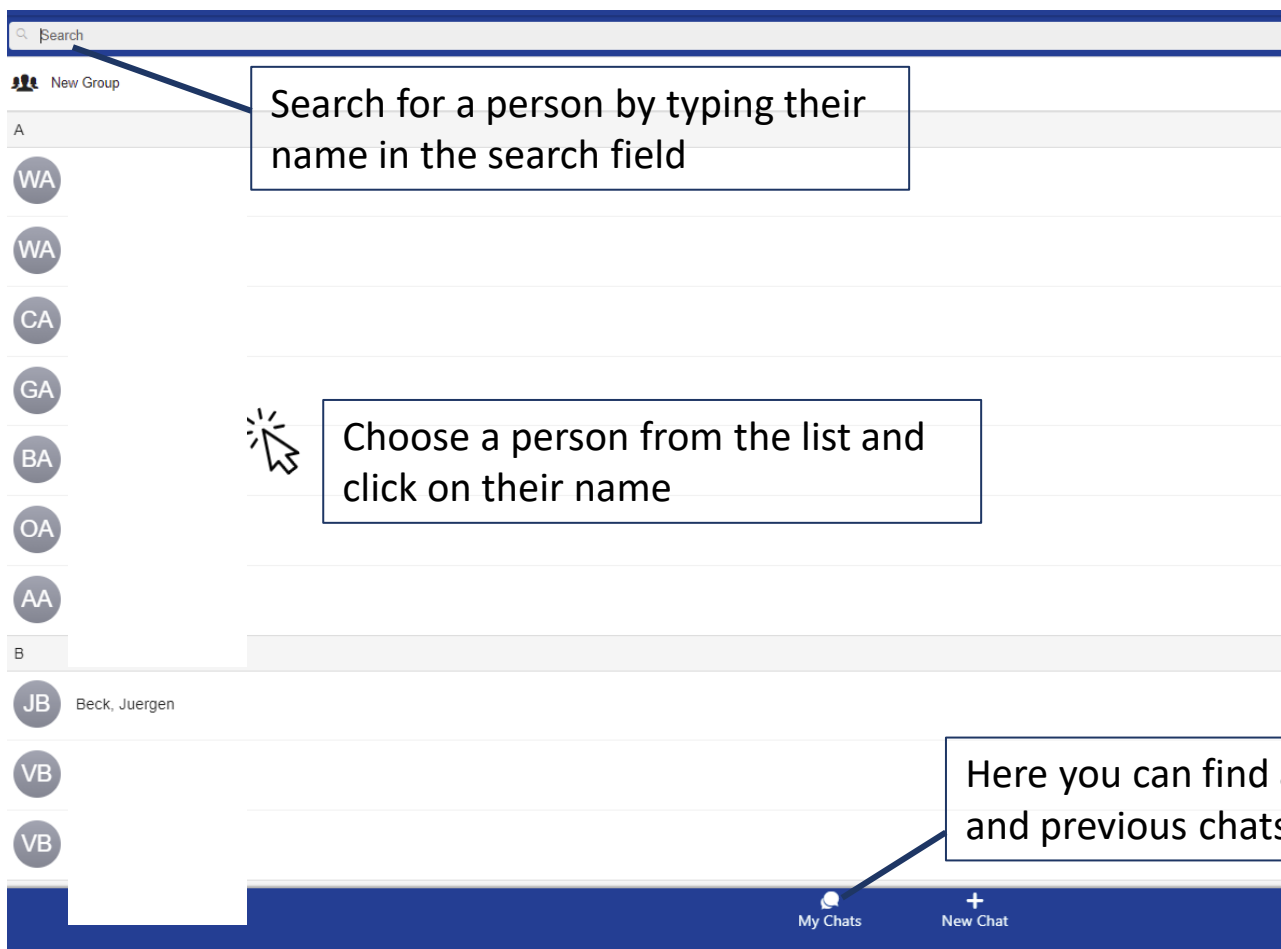
